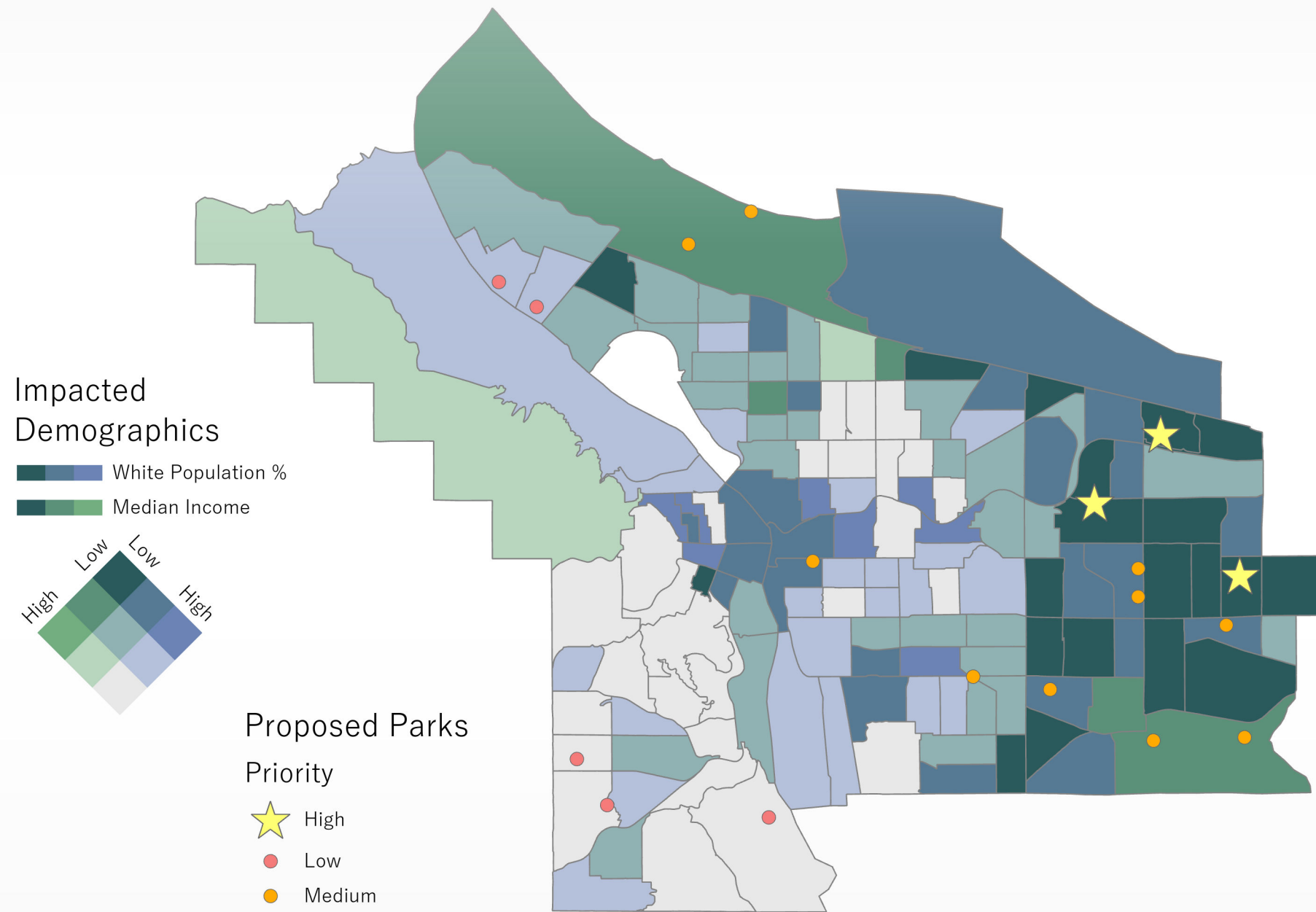


Closing the Play Gap in Portland, Oregon



In 2020, The City of Portland Parks and Recreation Department sent new goals for park access with The City's Five Year Racial Equity Plan. In their aim to provide natural areas within one half mile of all residents, proposed new parks projects are prioritized by need. Historically areas of lower income and higher people of color populations have less access to park areas. By comparing these demographics in census tracks across the city the highest priority park projects are identified above.
